- EVENT VOLUNTEER** During the evening of GradNite, event volunteers help maintain fun and security wherever needed. Perfect for people who do not want an on-going commitment but who want to be involved at GradNite. Lots and lots of volunteers are needed! Details on your specific work assignment will be mailed 2 weeks prior to GradNite.
- SET-UP Committee** These committee members help our Decorations committee get PHS ready for GradNite a few days prior to, and the day of, GradNite. Set-up times are flexible and you can work around other commitments. Lots of volunteers are needed!
- FACILITIES Committee** ****new for 2012**** These committee members are vital the afternoon of GradNite to ensure that all spaces and fixtures (tables, chairs, tents, risers, etc.) are in place and ready to go after graduation. You will work with the Chairperson and PHS custodial staff for 2-3 hours to be sure things go smoothly!
- FOOD Committee** This committee is responsible for planning the menu at GradNite, procuring and purchasing food and beverages for GradNite. Food committee members help during the week of set-up and may help staff the popular food and beverage areas during GradNite.
- DECORATIONS Committee** Committee members help create and set-up the decorations needed to turn PHS into the ultimate party. Creative minds and artistic ability are welcome, *but not required*. Many willing hands are needed!
- HOSPITALITY Committee** Committee members welcome the graduates and staff the check in/check out areas during GradNite..
- COLLAGE Committee** This committee helps create the special and personal keepsake collages for each graduate to take home. During GradNite, committee members may help supervise the collage viewing area.
- ENTERTAINMENT Committee** This committee is responsible for planning entertainment activities for the event. Committee members may help during GradNite supervising games and activities.
- FUND-RAISING Committee** This committee oversees fund-raising efforts. New ideas and big dreams are always welcomed. Knowledge of Excel and grant writing (*or willingness to try!*) would be very helpful.
- PRIZES Committee** Committee members are involved in shopping for prizes to be given away at GradNite and setting up the prize area. If you can bargain and love a great deal, this committee is for you!
- MEDICAL Committee** This committee handles any medical situations that arise during GradNite and catalogues all paperwork that is required for the event. Generally this committee is best suited for RNs, MDs, or other persons trained in a medical field.
